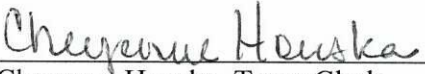
1. Discussion and appropriate action regarding request by City of Altus to relocate the Duke master meter and the consequential reduction of length of waterline maintained by Duke.
